Course Objectives

During the course, students will:

- Review, learn, and practice the most important A2/B1 grammatical points (listed below).
- Communicate in everyday situations with improved accuracy.
- Connect ideas in simple sentences and short texts.
- Express opinions, give advice, and make suggestions using correct grammar.
- Increase confidence in using English grammar for real communication.

- Past Tenses: Past Simple (regular and irregular verbs), Past Continuous
- Future Forms: Will, Going to, Present Continuous for future plans
